Who Can Attend?

Eligibility is determined by a pediatric cardiologist's recommendation and approval by our medical and leadership teams. Our campers see a cardiologist on a regular basis, are independent in living skills and heart disease is their primary health concern. Most campers have had cardiac surgery and take daily cardiac medications.

How Is Camp Staffed?

Camp programs are under the supervision and direction of skilled cardiologists and nurses, along with a team of energetic, trained counselors and program directors.

What Does Camp Cost?

Thanks to the generosity of individual donors, corporations and fundraisers, campers can attend any program for \$25. The actual cost per camper ranges from \$250 to \$900 depending upon the program.
