Who Can Attend?

Eligibility is determined by a pediatric cardiologist's recommendation and approval by our medical and leadership teams. Our campers see a cardiologist on a regular basis and heart disease is their primary physical health diagnosis. Most campers have had cardiac surgery and take daily cardiac medications.

Our campers exhibit age-appropriate social and behavioral skills, are independent in living skills, and effectively participate in group-based activities. To see details about our essential camper functions, visit www.campodayin.org/faqs.

What Does Camp Cost?

Thanks to the generosity of donors, corporations and fundraisers, campers can attend any program for \$25. We provide a sliding payment scale during registration to ensure that cost is not a barrier to joining us. We provide transportation scholarships for those in need.

Summer Residential Camp

Grades 1-11, in Crosslake, MN or Elkhorn, WI
A 5-day overnight camp experience with horseback riding, water sports, arts and crafts, archery, campfires, talent show and more. Activities vary depending on location.

Summer Day Camp

Grades K-3, in St. Paul, MN
A 5-day intro-to-camp experience for youngsters to enjoy crafts, games, nature activities, and new friends.

Winter Camp

Grades 1-12, in Amery, WI
A 3-day weekend for campers who attended Residential or Day Camp the previous summer. Reconnect with friends over snow-tubing, broomball, hot chocolate, and tons of indoor fun.

How Do I Apply?

Fall Family Camp

A 3-day weekend in Amery, WI (near Minneapolis/St. Paul) or Camp Lake, WI (near Milwaukee/Chicago) packed with creative and friendship-building activities plus educational opportunities for families who have a child with heart disease up to 12th grade (no minimum age).

Moms Retreat

A 2-day weekend in Stillwater, MN for moms of children with heart disease up to 12th grade (no minimum age). Moms provide mutual emotional support, take time for self-care, gain new resources, and learn from experts.



How Is Camp Staffed?

Camp programs are under the supervision and trained direction of skilled volunteer nurses and cardiologists, along with a team of energetic camp counselors and program directors.


