General Release and Camper Expectations

General Release

I give permission for my child to virtually attend Camp Odayin and participate in the scheduled program. I recognize the possible risk involved for my child in participating in online activities, including risks associated with online piracy, security, and invasion of privacy. I release, discharge, and otherwise agree to indemnify Camp Odayin, its affiliated organizations and sponsors, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, and agents against any claim by or on behalf of myself or my minor child as a result of my child's participation in any program or activity sponsored, coordinated, or supervised by Camp Odayin.

I give permission for my child to access the Zoom platform using the password provided by Camp Odayin to participate in large and small group activities. I will not share the Camp Odayin log-in information to Zoom or the password to the protected webpage on Camp Odayin's website. If my child is under the age of 12, I agree to have an adult nearby who is available during the hours of virtual camp. I will be aware of their background and what/who is visible and/or can be heard. I release Camp Odayin from any responsibility for use of internet searches outside of camp channels. I agree to talk to my child about being online, such as safety, online searches, oversharing and cyber bullying. I give permission on behalf of my minor child that Camp Odayin may make audio/visual recordings and photographs during Virtual Camp. Recordings are the property of Camp Odayin and Camp Odayin shall have the right to use photographs and audio/visual recordings to promote public understanding and support for children with heart disease and other media, promotional and/or advertising purposes. I further give permission that any photographs may be published and used by the American Camp Association and its agents, to illustrate and promote the camp experience.

Note: All sessions will be recorded; however, attendees will have the option to turn off their video camera.

I give permission for the Camp Odayin staff and board of directors to discuss my child's health and any information I provide in the camper registration forms. I authorize Camp Odayin to contact my child's cardiologist regarding any medical questions, or obtain records from office visits, in case additional information is needed.

If I have any questions or concerns regarding this waiver, I will contact Camp Odayin to discuss.

Camper Expectations

Our hope is that Camp Odayin will be a place for campers to make friends and find support. In order for Camp Odayin to be safe, fun and enjoyable for everyone, there are some expectations to discuss with your child.

1. I will choose THE ODAYIN WAY while at Camp Odayin:

- I will be Helpful
- I will be Encouraging
- I will be Accepting
- I will be Respectful
- I will be Thankful

2. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking or tobacco products are not allowed during the hours of virtual camp. Camp Odayin has the right to remove a camper from the Zoom meeting without warning if the Camp Director suspects these products have been used.

3. Physical, sexual or suggestive behavior is not appropriate or acceptable at Camp Odayin.

4. During scheduled virtual camp times, campers will only use the Zoom platform to contact camp staff and fellow campers.

5. Screen shots, recording, and private, separate chats are not allowed during virtual camp sessions.

6. My background will be appropriate, such as but not limited to, a blank wall, or a virtual background image.

7. I will follow the guidelines for appropriate chat conversations.

a. If you ever feel uncomfortable, tell your trusted adult

b. No secrets. (Surprises are different. Surprises make us feel good and are intended to share eventually. Secrets are not ever meant to share and can feel bad.)

c. Good messages are ones that would parent/guardians excited to see and hear and the person sharing it with you would want your parent/guardians to see and hear the message.

d. Cussing, swearing and foul language is not acceptable at Camp Odayin.

8. In the interest of respecting participants' privacy, I will not take screenshots or to record in any manner breakout rooms, chats or other virtual camp activities.
