Volunteers receive resources and training, including:

- Medical orientation to support children with heart disease
- Strategies for listening to kids effectively, managing challenging behaviors, and encouraging growth
- Methods for fostering diversity, acceptance and inclusion

VOLUNTEERS MUST:

- Be 20 years of age or older (by the 1st day of camp)
- Nurses must have a LPN, RN, or NP license
- Believe in creating inclusive, welcoming settings for all
- Find joy in working with youth
- Possess communication skills, maturity, and patience
- Have the enthusiasm and endurance to supervise campers at all times
